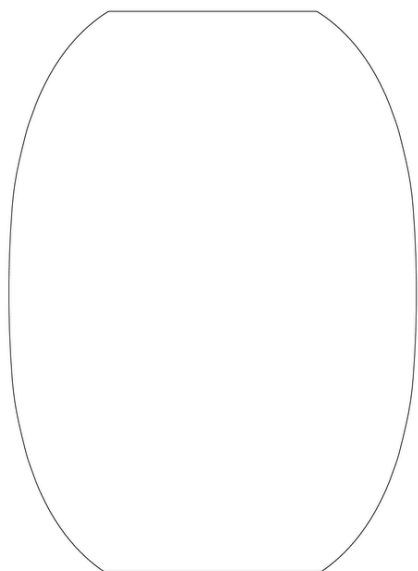

BACKGROUND

The SUPER vase is designed after Piet Hein's Superellipse® and, with its simple expression, is a natural part of the decor. The vase is mouth-blown, making each vase unique, although they all share the soft expression of the superellipse. Since the vase is mouth-blown, small air bubbles may occur, adding character to the vase. We discard vases with significant air bubbles.

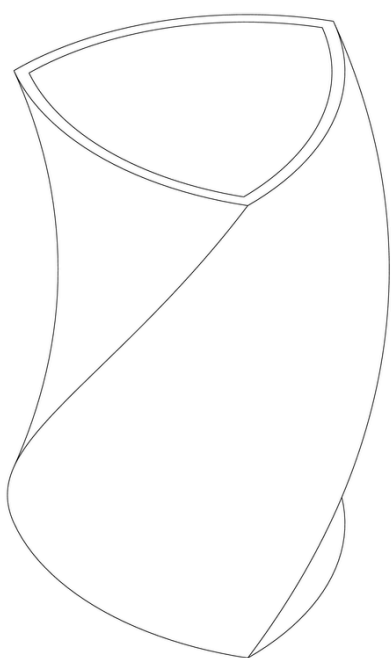

BACKGROUND

Piet Hein was often inspired by people, nature, and architecture. Architecture, in particular, was a significant source of inspiration for the TWISTER vase, which Piet Hein conceived after closely studying Copenhagen's old city hall, now known as the Copenhagen City Court at Nytorv. He was captivated by the columns in front of the main entrance and the idea of "twisting" three of them together. This idea eventually became the TWISTER vase, a remarkable sculpture and a beautiful vase for flowers and branches. Like the SUPER vase, the TWISTER vase is mouth-blown.

BACKGROUND

The Southern Cross is a constellation in the southern night sky and, in Piet Hein's design, a four-armed, timeless candleholder. Like its "big brother," Great Bear, it has flexible arms. This means that the Southern Cross can stand perfectly straight on the table for lunch, fitting into a modern, sleek setting, and then, for the evening meal, it can shine from various "angled" positions, adding a relaxed ambiance.

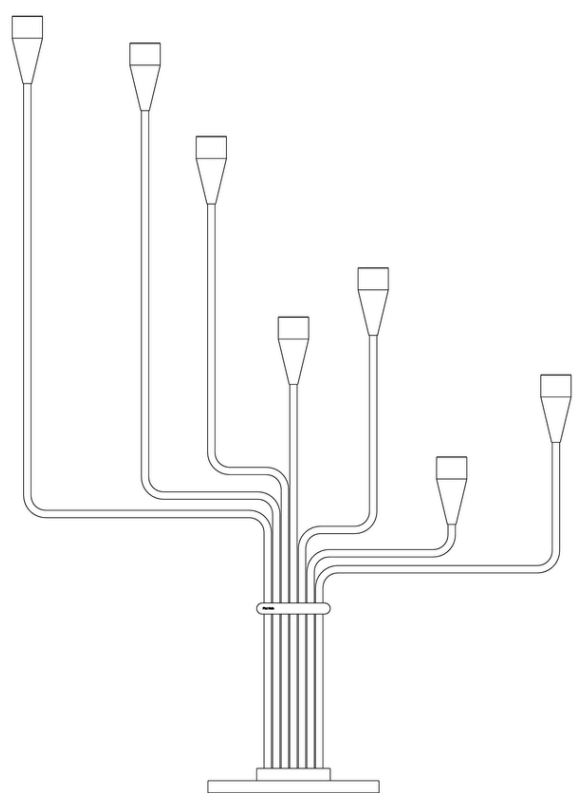

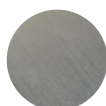
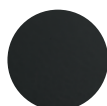
The idea for the Great Bear came to Piet Hein in 1944 in Argentina, where he was living at the time and came to miss the northern night sky. Piet Hein began experimenting with transferring the constellation to a seven-branched candelabra that could shine anywhere in the world. After returning to Denmark, one prototype was made, followed by many more. Today, the Great Bear is still ideal for both creating a cosmic, pleasant atmosphere and being a sculptural piece of solid Danish design in the home. The seven arms are flexible, so the candles can shine in a row or from multiple angles.

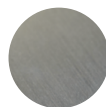
BACKGROUND

HISTORIE

SOMA is one of Piet Hein's mathematical brilliancies that garnered significant international attention. The idea for SOMA came to him in 1933 during a lecture on quantum physics by Werner Heisenberg. While the famous German physicist discussed a space divided into cubes, Piet Hein conceived an extraordinary geometric theory: By taking all the irregular shapes that can be formed by at most four cubes - all of the same size and connected along a lateral face - these shapes could be assembled into a larger cube.

BACKGROUND

The tray was first put into production by Kay Bojesen in the early 1960s with a design by Piet Hein. Back then, it was made of teak, while this tray is made of oak, which gives it a sense of lightness and elegance.

The tray is not dishwasher safe; it should only be wiped clean with a damp cloth. Not suitable for hot items, as they may damage the natural wood. By maintaining the tray with regular neutral oil, you can ensure it lasts for many years, while continuing the legacy of the remarkable superellipse® design.

The chair is Custom Design, where you can choose between a seat and backrest in wood or upholstered with leather, textile or wool.

BACKGROUND

Piet Hein developed the chair based on the superellipse, a shape he originally conceived for a combined city square and roundabout at Sergels Torg in Stockholm. Using mathematics, Piet Hein arrived at a harmonious geometric form which he subsequently used in various contexts.

The superelliptical chair and barstool stand as fine examples of Piet Hein's approach to imagining form and function. His ability to distill to the essence, both in words and physical materials, is undeniable, perhaps explaining why the chairs still appear refreshingly modern today.
